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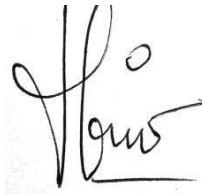
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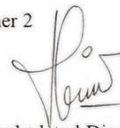
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ABSTRACT

This research aims to analyze the dysfunctional parental roles in families and the effects of dysfunctional parenting roles on their daughters. This analysis is taken from the novel *Daisy Darker* by Alice Feeney. Frank and Nancy are a young married couple who got married by accident. From this marriage, they have three daughters, namely Rose, Lily, and Daisy. This marriage affects their parenting. They are not ready to get married, which makes their families dysfunctional and affects their daughters; therefore, the researcher is interested in analyzing this family life. The researcher has two goals: (1) to find out dysfunctional parental roles in Daisy's family and (2) to find out the effects of dysfunctional parental roles on their daughters.

The researcher uses a qualitative approach with descriptive methods. This method is suitable for analyzing the chosen topic because the data used by the author is in the form of quotations from the novel. The researcher collected the data by carefully reading and understanding the novel. After that, the researcher highlights the problems appropriate to the analyzed topic. The researcher underlines dysfunctional parental role patterns and the effects of dysfunctional parental role patterns. The researcher also uses new criticism and phenomenology theory to support the analysis conducted by the researcher.

This research shows that Daisy's parents have dysfunctional parental roles. Her father, Frank, often neglected his family because he was obsessed with music. Apart from that, he also needed better communication, which frequently caused problems to go unsolved. Nancy, as a mother, also shows dysfunctional parenting. She has a favorite daughter and causes favoritism towards others. Nancy also has poor communication skills, so she often ignores problems. Apart from that, Nancy also discriminates against her other daughter. The effects of this dysfunctional parenting make Lily a selfish person who likes to bully and does not want to admit her mistakes. Daisy becomes a person who is always jealous, a liar, and likes revenge.

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis polah asuh orang tua pada keluarga yang tidak berfungsi serta efek dari polah asuh yang tidak berfungsi tersebut pada anak mereka. analisis ini diambil dari novel berjudul *Daisy Darker* karya Alice Feeney. Frank dan Nancy adalah pasangan suami istri muda yang menikah karena sebuah kecelakaan. Dari pernikahan tersebut, mereka telah mempunyai tiga anak yaitu Rose, Lily, dan Daisy. Pernikahan tersebut memberikan efek pada pola asuh mereka. Mereka yang belum siap pada sebuah pernikahan membuat dampak keluarganya tidak berfungsi dan berefek pada anak-anak mereka oleh karena itu peneliti tertarik untuk menganalisis kehidupan keluarga ini. Peneliti memiliki dua tujuan: (1) untuk mengetahui pola asuh yang tidak berfungsi pada keluarga Daisy dan (2) untuk mengetahui efek dari keluarga yang tidak berfungsi pada anak-anak mereka.

Peneliti menggunakan pendekatan kualitatif dengan metode deskriptif. Metode ini cocok untuk menganalisis topic yang dipilih karena data yang digunakan oleh penulis berupa kutipan-kutipan dalam novel. Peneliti mengumpulkan data dengan membaca dan memahami novel tersebut dengan seksama. Setelah itu peneliti menggaris bawahi permasalahan yang sesuai dengan tpik yang diteliti. Peneliti menggaris bawahi tentang pola asu yan tidak berfungsi dan efek dari pola asuh yang tidak berfungsi tersebut. peneliti juga menggunakan teori new criticism dan phenomenologi untuk mendukung peneitian yang dilakukan oleh peneliti.

Penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa pola asuh dari orang tua Daisy merupakan pola asuh orang tua yang tidak berfungsi. Ayah mereka, Frank, sering menelantarkan keluarga demi obsesinya terhadap music selain itu dia juga memiliki komunikasi yang buruk sehingga sering menyebabkan masalah tidak selesai. Nancy sebagai ibu juga menunjukkan pola asuh yang tidak berfungsi. Dia mempunyai anak kesayangan dan mengakibatkan pilih kasih terhadap yang lain. Nancy juga memiliki komunikasi yang buruk sehingga sering mengabaikan masalah selain itu Nancy juga mendiskriminasi anaknya yang lain. efek dari pola asuh yang tidak berfungsi ini menjadikan Lily anak yang egois, suka membuli, dan todak mau mengakui kesalahan. Daisy juga menjadi anak yang suka iri, pembohong, dan suka balas dendam.
